
Business Challenge

- Transactional Supply Chain sought to transform into a world-class organization, but lacked capital, experienced personnel, and a plan to evolve
- Entrenched culture of vendor, contract, and sourcing decision making resided in business units. Buy-in to change legacy go-to-market approaches was infrequent.
- Supply Chain orientation historically was highly decentralized. Few contracts had leveraged spend beyond a single business unit or plant.

Solution and Benefits

- Delivered an opportunity assessment and associated savings execution roadmap that identified immediate savings opportunities to meet the Utility's goals
- Led execution of strategic sourcing and savings initiatives from the savings roadmap and beyond to create \$700MM in cumulative savings in three years
- Instituted a standardized strategic sourcing process and delivered a training program that developed skill sets of new Supply Chain Professionals
